

Minnesota's Machinery Museum consists of five large buildings (25,000 sq. ft.) on a beautiful sixacre site. The complex houses the state's largest collection of agricultural equipment and exhibits, recalling a century of farm life in stories and artifacts.



Stroll through a farm home kitchen, parlor, bedroom, a turn-of-the-century blacksmith shop and general store. Enjoy the collection of vintage automobiles, restored gas engines, and mint condition tractors dated back to 1912. Don't miss the railroad memorabilia, implements, tools and excellent miniature and toy farm machinery collections.



Guided tours are always available, upon request, for any number of visitors. Special tours available for schools, including demonstrations.
